

## Fabric Requirements

For the Dresden blocks, we planned 9 colorways. We selected five fabrics for each block, and cut each fabric four times. (There are 20 fans per block.)

- (45) 11" × 7" rectangles in various colors for Dresden fans
- (9) 4" × 4" squares in various colors for Dresden fan **centers**
- 2¼ yards white for **backgrounds** Cut (9) 15" × 15" squares
- 3 yards for **backing** (based on 43" wide fabric)
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard for **binding**



Use the 6" fan on your Dresden Plate Ruler to cut 4 fans from each fabric.

Creative Grids<sup>®</sup> Non-Slip 18 Degree Dresden Plate Ruler

## **Recommended Products:**

Olfa® Spinning Rotary Mat Prairie Pointer Roxanne® Glue-Baste-It® MonoPoly™ Clear Thread

To finish the quilt as seen in the video, sew the 9 blocks together, 3 rows by 3 columns, pressing all seams open. Quilt and bind as desired.
