# **SNOWBALL BLOCK**

## PLEASE NOTE

\_\_\_\_\_ All seam allowances are <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" RST - Right Sides Together

For drawing lines on dark fabric, we recommend the Sewline Fabric Pencil - white 1.3mm, available at Shabby Fabrics.com

### CUT FABRICS\_\_\_\_\_

From **dark blue**, cut:

• (4)  $1\frac{1}{4}$  ×  $1\frac{1}{4}$  squares for **Snowball corners** 

From **teal**, cut:

• (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square for **Snowball center** 

## SNOWBALL BLOCK


**<u>STEP 1</u>**: On the back of each dark blue square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Place a blue square in the upper left corner of a teal square, RST, noting the orientation of the diagonal.

STEP 2: Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press to the outside.


**<u>STEP 3</u>**: Repeat Steps 1–2 for upper right corner.

STEP 4: Repeat Steps 1-2 for lower corners, but press seams to the inside. (This will help the seams nest when you join the blocks in a later step.)


Snowball Block should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".




