REQUIRED

- (1) Fat Quarter **each** of (4) **Valentine** fabrics
- ½ yard **each** of (2) **pink** fabrics
- (1) 12" heart wire wreath frame

cut fabric

From **each** of (4) **Valentine** fabrics, cut:


- (3) 7" × 18" strips, subcut to
(27) 7" × 2" rectangles

From **each** of (2) **pink** fabrics, cut:

- (6) 7" × 18" strips, subcut to
(54) 7" × 2" rectangles

You will have a total of (216) rectangles: (108) Valentine
and (108) pink.

For sample project, we used a total of (196) rectangles.




fill wreath

Fold (1) fabric rectangle lengthwise, which will make a narrow strip that will be easier to loop-and-knot.




Fold strip in half to form a loop.

Beginning in a section near one end of the wreath frame, thread fabric loop behind one wire.




Thread fabric ends through loop.



Pull fabric ends firmly to secure knot.

Repeat steps, arranging fabric strips as desired, to fill wreath.
