Let's get started! This is a Pinwheel Pine Block, made from our green fabrics.

## REQUIRED MATERIALS

Items required to complete this block:

- (1) $7^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$ of green $\mathbf{1}$ fabric
-(1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2}$ " of green 2 fabric
- (1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ of green 3 fabric
- (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ of green 4 fabric
- (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 21$ " of brown fabric

- (1) $8^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ cream fabric

## CUT FABRICS

From green 1 fabric, cut:
-(3) $41 / 4$ " $\times 41 / 4$ " squares
Cut in half - twice - on the diagonal


From green 2 fabric, cut:
-(2) $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares
Cut in half - twice - on the diagonal


From green 3 fabric, cut:
-(1) $41 / 4$ " $\times 41 / 4$ " square
Cut in half - twice - on the diagonal $\square$
From green 4 fabric, cut:

- Use templates to cut shapes (see page 3)
(1) Template D
(1) Template F

From brown fabric, cut:

- Use templates to cut shapes (see page 3)
(1) Template B
(1) Template E

From cream fabric, cut:

- (1) $67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / 8^{"}$ square

Cut in half - once - on the diagonal $\square$

- (1) $43 / 8$ " $\times 43 / 8$ " square

Cut in half - once - on the diagonal $\square$
