## REQUIRED MATERIALS

- $3^{11 / 4}$ yards black fabric
- FQ - $1 / 2$ yard each of 6 pinks, 6 oranges, 6 yellows, 6 greens, 6 blues, and 6 purples
- Creative Grids ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Pineapple Trim Tool


## NOTES

This quilt REQUIRES the use of the Creative Grids ${ }^{\ominus}$ Pineapple Trim Tool, available at ShabbyFabrics.com While the instructions to make the pineapple quilt block are included with the Pineapple Trim Tool, we've recorded a YouTube video, making it even easier to understand how to use the tool.

## CUT THE FABRIC

From black, cut:

- (54) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips
- (6) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding

From one fabric in each color, fussy cut:

- (5) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " squares

These will be the center square of each block
Refer to the Trim Tool instructions on how to cut the remaining fabrics to build your blocks. Fussy cut as you go to achieve desired look.

## MAKE THE BLOCKS

Referring to the instructions included with the Creative Grids ${ }^{\oplus}$ Pineapple Trim tool, make (5) pineapple blocks in each color: pink, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple, pressing seams away from the center.
Each block should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2}$ ".

## ASSEMBLE THE QUILT

Sew blocks together in rows: pink, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple, pressing seams as desired.
Sew rows together, pressing seams as desired.

## FINISH

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired.
Sew binding strips into one long, continuous strip. Fold binding strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Line up raw edges of the binding strip with the raw edge of the quilt. Sew the binding to the front side of the quilt, starting at any side. Turn the binding over and hand stitch to the back of the quilt.
