BEACH BALL BLOCK

PLEASE NOTE

All seam allowances are 1/4" RST - Right Sides Together

CUT FABRIC_____

From **light**, cut:
• (2) 27/8" × 27/8" squares

From **dark**, cut:


• (2) 2\%" × 2\%" squares

From **background**, cut:

• (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares




STEP 1: On the back of one light 2%" × 2%" square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. **STEP 2:** Layer this light square and one dark 2%" × 2%" square, RST, making sure to line up the edges. **STEP 3:** Shorten your stitch length and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line. **STEP 4:** Cut on the drawn line. Press toward dark. **STEP 5:** You will now have two Half Square Triangles (HST).









STEP 6: Repeat Steps 1-5 to make two more HST. You will now have four HST. Lay them out and sew them together as shown, pressing seams open. **STEP 7:** On the back of one 1½" × 1½" background square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner, and place in one corner, RST, noting the orientation of the diagonal line. **STEP 8:** Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to ½". Press to the outside. **STEP 9:** Using three additional 1½" × 1½" background squares, repeat steps 7-8 for the three remaining corners. Beach Ball Block should measure 4½" × 4½".
