## BEACH BALL BLOCK

## PLEASE NOTE

All seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " RST - Right Sides Together

## CUT FABRIC

From light, cut:

- (2) $27 / 8$ " $\times 27 / 8$ " squares

From dark, cut:

- (2) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares


From background, cut:
-(4) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 1 / 2$ " squares

## BEACH BALL BLOCK

STEP 1: On the back of one light $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. STEP 2: Layer this light square and one dark $278^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, RST, making sure to line up the edges. STEP 3: Shorten your stitch length and sew $1 / 4$ " on both sides of the drawn line. STEP 4: Cut on the drawn line. Press toward dark. STEP 5: You will now have two Half Square Triangles (HST).


STEP 6: Repeat Steps 1-5 to make two more HST. You will now have four HST. Lay them out and sew them together as shown, pressing seams open. STEP 7: On the back of one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 / 2 "}$ background square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner, and place in one corner, RST, noting the orientation of the diagonal line. STEP 8: Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ ". Press to the outside. STEP 9: Using three additional $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " background squares, repeat steps 7-8 for the three remaining corners. Beach Ball Block should measure $41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
