# SCRUNCHIE WITH TAILS

#### REQUIRED MATERIALS

- (1)  $3" \times 16"$  fabric rectangle for **scrunchie**
- (1) 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" length elastic
- (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " × 16<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" fabric rectangles for **tails**

#### Make the Scrunchie

**STEP 1:** Place **scrunchie** fabric wrong side up. Fold one of the short edges up  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and press.



**STEP 2:** Fold rectangle in half lengthwise, right sides together. Press and pin.

**STEP 3:** Sew long edge together with <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowance.



**STEP 4:** Turn fabric right side out and press.



**STEP 5:** Pull **elastic** through fabric tube. Sew two ends of elastic together using a zig zag stitch. (For round/corded elastic, tie in a knot and trim ends.)





**STEP 6:** Tuck raw end of tube inside the finished end, and sew together.

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### MAKE THE TAILS\_\_\_\_\_

**STEP 1:** Trace template below onto freezer paper, and cut to shape.

**STEP 2:** Place (2) **tails** rectangles right sides together, and fold in half. Pin template to fabric, aligning at the fold.


**STEP 3:** Cut out tails shape along traced line.

STEP 4: Sew around tails with 1/4" seam allowance, leaving an opening for turning.

STEP 5: Turn right side out, pushing corners out. Press.

**STEP 6 (optional):** If desired, sew opening closed at this time. For sample project, we left the opening, because it will be hidden away inside the knot.

**STEP 7:** Refer to sample image on page 1 to tie tails around scrunchie. For sample project, we used the tails to cover the seam on the scrunchie.



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
