
### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Makes 4 Placemats and 8 Coasters

- ½ yard **each** of 4 dark orange fabrics
- FQ **each** of 4 orange fabrics for appliqué
- scraps of brown for appliqué
- scraps of green for appliqué
- scraps of yellow for appliqué
- scraps of white for appliqué
- 2½ yards fusible web
- 1 yard fusible fleece

## Placemat

Dashed lines indicate where one piece lies behind another piece.  
Numbers indicate the order in which the pieces should be placed.




# BASIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLACEMATS AND COASTERS

## PREPARE YOUR DIAGRAM

1. Align arrows on diagram as instructed, and tape pages together.
2. Roughly cut around pumpkin and candy corn shapes.

## PREPARE YOUR BACKGROUND AND BACKING SHAPES

1. Fold dark orange fabric, right sides together. Your folded fabric will measure 17" x 21½".
2. Arrange shapes on folded fabric as pictured in this diagram to make (1) placemat and (4) coasters.



3. Repeat steps 1-2 with remaining orange fabrics to make a total of (4) placemats and (8) coasters.
4. Cut (4) placemat shapes and (8) coaster shapes from fusible fleece.

Align arrows on page 1 with arrows on page 2,  
then join pages with tape.

Align arrows on page 2 with arrows on page 4,  
then join pages with tape.

Align arrows on page 1 with arrows on page 3,  
then join pages with tape.



Align arrows on page 3 with arrows on page 4,  
then join pages with tape.

Align arrows on page 2 with arrows on page 4,  
then join pages with tape.

### PLACEMAT APPLIQUÉ

1. Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
2. Fuse pumpkin center, leaf, and stem shapes in place. Wait to applique the pumpkin face until assembly is complete.

### PLACEMAT ASSEMBLY


1. Place placemat background and backing, right sides together, on top of a placemat-sized fusible fleece, and iron in place.
2. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " around entire pumpkin, leaving an opening for turning.
3. Trim fleece and clip curves.
4. Turn right side out and push seams out.
5. Appliqué face shapes in place.
6. Top stitch around entire pumpkin. This will close the opening.
7. Stitch appliqué using a complementary thread.

# Coaster



## COASTER APPLIQUÉ

1. Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
2. Arrange appliqué shapes on candy corn background and fuse in place.

## COASTER ASSEMBLY

1. Place coaster top and backing, right sides together, on top of a coaster-sized fusible fleece, and iron in place.
2. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " around entire candy corn, leaving an opening for turning.
3. Turn right side out through opening, and press.
4. Top stitch around entire coaster, and stitch appliqué using a complementary thread. This will close the opening.

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
